

CTF Annual Meeting Changes – Canadian Mixed Championships Cancelled

On Saturday July 25, the Board of Directors for the Canadian Tenpin Federation unanimously approved the cancellation of the “in person” Annual Meeting of Members due to Covid19 health concerns. The 2020 Annual Meeting will proceed as scheduled on November 14, 2020 utilizing Zoom videoconferencing services and details will be shared at a later time.
