Schedule of Benefits

Principal Sum: \$100,000, Weekly Accident Indemnity: \$350, Accident Reimbursement Expense: \$15,000

For the purposes of this policy Insured persons shall be considered as all authorized volunteer workers of the member's churches, schools, healthcare and non-profit societies of the Policyholder under the age of 60.

One arm	4/5 of Principal Sum
One leg	4/5 of Principal Sum
One hand	¾ of Principal Sum
One foot	¾ of Principal Sum
Thumb or index finger or least 4 fingers of one hand	2/5 of Principal Sum

For Paralysis of Both upper & lower limbs, both lower limbs and upper and lower limbs of one side of the body – the principal sum

Description: SSQ Accidental Death/Dismemberment Policy covers Volunteers as noted under the policy for injuries sustained by an insured person while performing duties as assigned and authorized by the Canadian Tenpin Federation.
