Master Qualifying Rules

Optional Master or Super Scratch All-Events: \$50.00 per entry (\$50.00 prize money, \$0 expense fee). All Monies will be used towards entry fee and uniforms for Master's or Super Master's Team.

Participants may enter handicap All-Events.

Participants over the age of 50 in the year of the tournament are eligible to enter the optional Men's and Women's Masters Scratch All Events. Super Master must be the age of 60 in the year of the tournament. Canadian Tenpin Federation is not responsible if this event or any division is canceled. .

Qualifying will use the following format.

1. Entrants must bowl 9 games consisting of the total of three (3), three (3) game scratch series bowled during a team, doubles or singles event. Total entry fees \$150.00 plus 50 for masters or super masters all events.
2. Entrants may enter both Masters and Super Masters Division, and will be placed on the Team with the highest score.
3. Entrants must select the event and squad selection on the entry form and pay the additional optional fee.
4. Entrants may enter additional squads for \$15.00. The best three (3) scratch series would be used for Master Qualifying. The first three events plus handicap will be used for cash prizes.
5. The top four (4) men and women will form the 2024 Masters Team Canada. The top 2 men and women will form the 2024 Super Masters Team Canada.
