Purpose

- 1. This policy covers all athletes and coaches attending events on behalf of The Canadian Tenpin Federation.
- 2. All items that are not covered in this policy must have prior approval from the High-Performance Director in advance.
- 3. This Policy will supersede and amend related articles as per their content in previous documents including the "Athlete's Agreement".

Once an athlete/coach is selected to be on Team Canada it is their responsibility to supply CTF with their size requirements in order for CTF to supply them with a uniform. New uniforms may not always be supplied for returning players/coaches. This is a decision based on updates to uniform, design changes and budgets.

Team Canada members may purchase additional items if they choose to <u>trade</u> away a jersey. The athlete/coach will be responsible for any uniform that has been traded.

If the athlete/coach trades more then one shirt away they will be responsible for paying to have the shirt replaced if they make the next team. Jackets are not to be traded.

The number of Jerseys supplied to each team may and can/will fluctuate each year based on budgets and updates needed.

The Team Coach/Manager will be supplied with the same uniform as the members of the team they are coaching/managing.

If an athlete is part of two teams in same year, they will be provided with one set of uniforms.

Canadian Tenpin Federation will be responsible for all uniforms. All additional uniforms needed must be ordered through the HPD, and not direct to supplier.

Coaches/Managers/Athletes must not use/consume Alcohol or be under the influence of alcohol during any CTF activity such as training camps or any international events. All uniform designs must be approved by the uniform committee.
