2025-26 Playing Rule Change Summary

There were several changes made to the CTF Playing Rules for 2025-26. This is a brief summary of the major changes. Housekeeping changes (typo's, grammar, etc.) are not listed.

- Chapter II General Playing Rules
 A paragraph was added in the introduction referencing CTF's Equity, Diversity, and Inclusivity policy.
- 2. Rule 4d Special Considerations to Deliver the Ball A section regarding wheelchair use was added.
- 3. Rule 6a Legal Pinfall
 A statement was added to say that it is considered to be legal pinfall if a pin(s) is knocked over by a string.
- 4. Chapter III CTF Awards: Rule 50 Eligibility
 A clarification was added that an adult award will be given to a Youth bowler when the accomplishment was achieved in an adult league.
- Rule 51 Special Achivement Awards
 Several awards had the qualifying average adjusted.
- 6. Rule 118b Average How established
 There was a clarification regarding a youth who uses a two-handed release (between the legs or chest-high), where there is no dominant hand. They would have to establish a new average if/when they change their delivery to one with a dominant hand (one-handed or two-handed).
